SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

To be read in conjunction with the Standard Sailing Instructions for Irish Provincial Championships.

The notation [NP] in a rule of the sailing instructions means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be notified via WhatsApp and duplicated on Official Notice Board located on the window of the Instructors Room under the main balcony.

5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the yard-arm on the front balcony of the Clubhouse.

9 THE COURSES

Trapezoid courses will be used. The diagrams in Attachment A show the courses, including the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

10 MARKS

Marks 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 will yellow inflatable marks. The start/finish mark will be a cylindrical orange inflatable.

11 AREAS THAT ARE OBSTRUCTIONS

There is an obstruction which is covered or partially covered at high tide running from Ferrybank Quay (which is on the opposite side of the river to the main town) to the 'Black Man' a stone beacon at the entrance to the River Slaney – do not sail between the beacon & Ferrybank Quay.
